Enactment The Zamfara State House of Assembly enacts as follows -

- Citation 1. This Law may be cited as Zamfara State Consolidated Revenue (Amendment) Law 2023.
- Commencement 2. This Law shall come into operation on the day of ... 2023
- Amendment of 3. The Zamfara State Consolidated Revenue Law No. 7, 2020 is the Principal Law amended as set out in this Law.
- Amendment of Section 4 of the principal Law is amended by complete deletion of the section and re-drafting as follows -
 - 4. (1) There is established for the Service a Board which shall comprise-
 - (a) The Executive Chairman of the Service as the Chairman who shall be
 - (i) Appointed by the Governor subject to confirmation by the State House of Assembly;

An indigene of the State; (ii)

(iii) A Member of a relevant and recognized

professional body;

Possess a minimum of first degree and at (iv) experience tax least Ten Years' in administration;

- The Executive Chairman shall hold office for (v) a term of four years and may be eligible for re-appointment for another period of four years and no more.
- Heads of such department as may be established (b) by the Board from time to time who shall be known as Executive Directors.
- A representative not below the Rank of Director from the following Ministries, Departments and or agencies -
 - Ministry of Finance; (i)
 - (ii) Ministry of Justice;
 - Ministry of Commerce and Industry; (iii)
 - (iv) Ministry for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs;
 - Ministry of Budget and Economic Planning; (v)
 - Government Ministry for Local (vi) Chieftaincy Affairs;
 - (vii) Traffic Enforcement Agencies of the State;
 - (viii) Housing and Town Planning;
- A Secretary of the Service to serve as the Secretary (d) of the Board;
- Three Part time members who shall be appointed by (e) the Governor, one from each senatorial zone of the State of high integrity with background in tax administration, whose tenure shall be for a term of four four years and may be eligible for re-appointment for another period of four years and no more.

- (2) The Executive Directors shall hold office for a period of four years and may be eligible for reappointment for another four years and no more.
 - (3) The Executive Directors and members of the Board shall be paid such emoluments, allowance and incidental expenses as may from time to time be determined by the Governor.

Amendment of 5. Section 9 of the Principal Law Section 9(1) of the principal is amended by substituting the words "Board" with the words "Service" at first line immediately after the words "a Secretary to the"

Amendment of 6. Section 64 of the Principal Law Section 64 of the Principal Law is amended by creating addition sub-sections 3 and 4 to read as follows;

- 64.(3) In this section Land use Charges shall include all Fees, Rents, Rates, Dues, Levies on real property including those beneath, off shore, onshore and above the land and sea.
 - (4) For the ease of administration, the Local Government in the State may cede their powers through Powers of Attorney to the Service for the assessment and collections of revenues collectable by Local Government as may be agreed by both parties.

Amendment of 7.
Section 45 of the
Principal Law

Section 45 of the principal is amended;

- (a) In sub-section (3) by inserting the words "or Tribunal" immediately after the words "High Court" in line 3 of the sub-section.
- (b) In sub-section (4) by Expunging the whole subsection and re-numbering of the sub-sections thereof.

Amendment of 8. the Principal Law

Principal Law is amended by creating in additional sections 144, 145, 146, 147 and 148 to read as follows;

Water Rate

144. The water rates charges payable for any property by all categories of persons and other taxable entities shall be as specified in the tenth schedule to this Law.

sealing properties

- Procedure of 145. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 45 of this Law or any other enactment, the service shall have the power to seal, impound and/or confiscate any premises or property in addition to the penalty prescribed under Section 43 of this law for the purpose collecting any of its Taxes, Rates, Levies or any taxable item or instrument provided under the schedules to this Law where the payer fails to comply with the provisions of this Law or any other enactment or may directly apply by an application Experte to the High court or tribunal for the grant of the order for sealing, impoundment or seizure
 - (2) Where the service seals, impounds and/or confiscates any premises or property of the tax payer it shall within two weeks after the sealing, impounding or confiscation of the premises or property as the case may be, apply by an application Experte to the High court or tribunal to authenticate the sealing or seizure of the premises or property.

Motion Experte Notwithstanding the provision of section 43 of the Principal Law or any other enactment, the Service may by an Application Experte apply to the Court or Tribunal for an order to seal, impound or confiscate any premises or property or may directly sealed or impound the premises or property.

Punishment 147

146.

Whoever violets the provision of Section 145 of this Law by unsealing or opening the sealed or pounded premises or property shall upon conviction be liable to a fine of One Hundred Thousand Naira (N100,000) or one month imprisonment for individual and Two Hundred Thousand Naira (N200,000) only for corporate body.

Schedule 148 Eleven

An additional schedule eleven is here by created in the schedule to this law.

ALTERATION OF FOURTH SCHEDULE

Subheading of item No. 5 of fourth Schedule is altered to read thus-Environmental/ecological fees and wherever impact assessment appear shall be replaced with environmental/ecological fees.
